



Let us support the families of Amhara prisoners of conscience.

In Ethiopia today, the Amhara people are facing grave and ongoing injustices. Many are being forcibly displaced from their homes. Innocent civilians including children, youth, and even elderly monks are being killed solely because of their identity. Others who dare to speak out in protest are subjected to imprisonment, beatings, and systemic injustice.

The suffering does not end with those imprisoned. Their families, children, elderly parents, and dependents are left without support and are often pushed into extreme hardship and hunger. Although various efforts have been made in the past to provide assistance, these responses have been fragmented and insufficient, failing to address the urgency and scale of the crisis.

We believe that the global community has a moral responsibility to stand with these families, victims of injustice who are enduring immense sacrifices. Among the prisoners of conscience are scholars, parliamentarians, teachers, journalists, medical professionals, and other resolute individuals who have contributed greatly to society.

To ensure meaningful and lasting support, assistance must be coordinated, organized, and sustained until justice is achieved and the Amhara people can live freely and safely with dignity. In response to this urgent need, a non-profit organization, "Solidarity for Families of Amhara Political Prisoners (SFAPP), has been established in Canada.

As the number of prisoners of conscience continues to rise, we encourage individuals and communities around the world to establish similar initiatives in their respective countries. Providing consistent support such as a monthly contribution of \$100 per affected family can help prevent these families from falling into destitution. However, broader participation and collective action are essential to meet the growing need.

We call on you to act. Organize in your communities, become members, expand your networks, raise awareness for those whose voices are unheard, and develop sustainable ways to generate support. For those in Canada, we invite you to join and strengthen this effort. We also encourage supporters worldwide to learn from the Canadian experience and replicate this model to amplify our collective impact.

Together, we can uphold our shared humanity and stand in solidarity with those in need.
